Dress Code Revision at D'Tanjong and D'Galaxy

Dress code bye-laws at D'Tanjong and D'Galaxy have been revised to allow Bermudas for men.

D'Tanjong - Bye-Law 4(a)(ii)

The following attires are strictly not allowed:

Dirty, sweaty and/or wet clothing, swimwear, singlets or sleeveless T-shirts and shorts, sandals without straps, flip-flops or slippers (except ladies' sandals/slippers and shorts including Bermuda shorts and Bermuda shorts for men with fully-covered shoes are permitted).

D'Galaxy - Bye-Law 43(ii)

Members and Guest are requested to be properly attired to enter D'Galaxy Room. At no time will those wearing soiled or wet clothing, swimwear, singlets, sleeveless T-shirts, slippers or strapless sandals be allowed into the premises. Only ladies may put on dress slippers or sandals (strapless or otherwise). Bermudas and shorts are permitted for ladies and Bermuda shorts for men with fully-covered shoes are permitted.

We would like to further supplement the 53rd Singapore National Age Group (SNAG) Junior & Senior 2023 write-up on page 12 in the Jun/Jul Issue.

Singapore Swimming Club sent 63 of its finest swim stars to participate in 310 Individual and 20 Relay events across the SNAG Junior and Senior competitions. They clinched **18 gold, 8 silver, and 13 bronze** medals. Congratulations to all the swimmers and medallists for their hard work and determination.

We also want to inform our readers that the **Elite B squad (Charisse Chin, Erin Tan, Trina Yap, and Isabelle Woo)** won **bronze** in the 4x50 Medley Relay and 4x50 Freestyle Relay events.

Dress Code at Jackson Miller



Jackson Miller has revised its dress code Bye-Law to disallow round neck t-shirts and Bermudas.

Bye-Law 4(c)

Proper jeans with smart trainers or covered shoes are permitted. Casual wear including Bermuda shorts are not permitted. No singlets, sports shorts, sleeveless T-shirts, round necks, swimwear, soiled or wet clothing (particularly after sports) and no flip-flops slippers and no flip-flops, sandals and torn jeans.

Park Within the Lots

We have observed that some vehicles are parked inappropriately at the Multi-storey Car Park. This inconveniences other users and may cause damage to vehicles.

We urge all motorists to exercise consideration and park their vehicles within the parking lots.

Bye-Law 14(b) (iv)

Vehicles parked indiscriminately and/or at unauthorised locations shall be wheel clamped and shall be liable for Wheel Clamp Release Fee of \$100.00.

Appropriate Display of Car Park Labels

The Club has revised the car park bye-law. We request that members adhere to the following:

Bye - Law 14(d)

Car Park Labels are the property of the Club and members shall be responsible for the car park labels issued to them:

- The labels shall be displayed prominently for identification and verification purposes
- Any member who misuses the label shall have their privilege withdrawn and shall be subject to disciplinary action

What is the role of the ICT Sub-Committee? During this term, what are some of its key focus areas?

The major project for this work year is the complete overhaul of the Club Management System (CMS), which will include features and functionalities that will improve the reliability and experience for all end-users. We look forward to members' support to embrace our digital transformation initiatives.

@ APMG 2023 @ KOREA JEONBUK 12 – 20 MAY 2023

After more than 3 years of COVID restrictions, approximately 58 Singapore Masters Athletes from various sports and groups participated in the Asia Pacific Masters Games (APMG) 2023 held at Korea Joellabuk-Do. The APMG Opening Ceremony was broadcast live on YouTube and is considered an Olympics for the Masters. 20 athletes from Track & Field represented the Singapore contingent, along with 15 from Wushu, 3 from Taekwondo (TKD), 18 from badminton, 1 from duathlon, and 1 from squash. Jeonbuk welcomed 15,000 athletes from 71 countries competing across 22 sports between 12 and 20 May 2023.

CHEF'S RECIPE

Chicken Bak Kut Teh

This popular dish traditionally uses pork ribs stewed in a herb-infused broth and is roughly translated as "meat bone tea". Instead of pork, this is a chicken-based version also known as Chik Kut Teh. Herby, peppery, and nutritious, this soup is a quintessential comfort food staple.

Ingredients

(4 to 5 servings)

1kg	Chicken (cut into pieces)
2ltr	Water or Chicken Stock
150g	Tofu Puffs
100g	Shitake Mushrooms
30g	Sliced Ginger
8 bulbs	Garlic
1 tbsp	Dark Soya Sauce
1 tbsp	Light Soya Sauce
1 tbsp	Ground White Pepper
1 tsp	Salt
2 pkt	Bak Kut Teh Herb Sachet

Method

1. Blanch the chicken in boiling water until it is no longer pink. Discard the water.
2. Parboil the chicken and add in all the ingredients except the tofu puffs and shiitake mushrooms.
3. Stir to incorporate the seasoning well into the soup and bring it to boil.
4. After the soup reaches boiling stage, lower the heat to simmer for 30 to 45 minutes.
5. Add tofu puffs and shiitake mushrooms and cook for 10 more minutes, until the chicken is well-cooked.

This dish can be served with steamed rice, red chillies in dark soy sauce, and Chinese parsley.
